



CITY PLAN COMMISSION FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE 2012-2017 SIX YEAR STREET PROGRAM

A Recommendation of the City Plan Commission certifying that the 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program is in conformance with the City of Spokane's Comprehensive Plan.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

A. In May 2001, the City of Spokane adopted its Comprehensive Plan under the Growth Management Act (Chapter 36.70A RCW or "GMA").

B. The City's Comprehensive Plan is required to be consistent with the GMA.

C. The GMA requires that the City's annual Six Year Street Program shall be in conformance with the City's Comprehensive Plan.

D. The 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program identifies capital project activity which has implications on the growth of the community.

E. The City Plan Commission held a workshop on April 27, 2011, and also held a public hearing on May 25, 2011, to obtain public comments on the 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program.

F. The City Council must receive a recommendation from the City Plan Commission to certify that the 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program is in conformance with the City's Comprehensive Plan in effect on the day of certification.

G. The proposed projects to be added are supported by Comprehensive Plan policy TR 2.3, Pedestrian/Bicycle Coordination.

H. The proposed projects to be added are supported by Comprehensive Plan policy TR 4.13, Traffic Signals.

I. The proposed projects to be added are supported by Comprehensive Plan policy TR 4.9, Downtown Accessibility.

ACTION: Motion to accept the staff's Findings of Fact A through F. Motion to accept the Plan Commissions amendments to Findings of Fact G through I.

CONCLUSIONS:

A. The 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program has been prepared in full consideration of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

B. The Spokane City Plan Commission concludes that the 2012-2017 Six Year Street Program is in full compliance with the existing Spokane Comprehensive Plan as required by RCW 36.70A and RCW 35.77.010, as well as the Arterial Street Plan.

ACTION: Motion to accept conclusions A and B by staff as conclusions of the Plan Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

A. By a vote of 8 to 0 , the Plan Commission recommends the approval of the 2012-2017 Six-Year Comprehensive Street Program by the City Council.
